



Packing & Moving Check List

(Tricks Of The Trade)

- Pack heavy items in small boxes: light items in larger boxes.
- Label boxes and indicate room allocation.
- Plates should be packed vertically & in special dish boxes for maximum protection.
- Use plenty of paper when packing fragile items.
- Make sure items with caps & lids are tightly secured.
- Do not move any perishables.
- Cushion framed pictures between blankets & comforters.
- Never overcrowd a box with fragile items.
- Remove bulbs & lampshades from lamps & pack separately.
- Most movers will let you store your clothes only in your bureau & dresser's.
(Ask your mover)
- Pack a box of essentials & mark it to be unloaded first.
- Take your phone book with you.
- A handful of coffee, baking soda or charcoal in an old sock will keep the inside of your refrigerator smelling fresh.
- If storing your goods, try and take a tour of the facility to be sure it is clean, dry & secure.
- Consider holding a garage sale or giving your unwanted items to charity.
- Give the Van Foreman a number where you can be reached or where messages can be left.
- Leave your pet with a friend or neighbor during all the activity of moving day.
- Movers prefer not to take live plants in the truck.
- If moving plants in your car, keep them away from windows to prevent scorching.
- At your new home, hook up your TV & VCR to keep your children occupied while your contents are being unloaded.
- Let your computer & all your electronic items become acclimatized to room temperature before plugging in.
- Relax & trust the professionals to do their job!
